General Instructions:

- Every participant is requested to register using the Google Form posted in our website
- Registration commences from 18th January 2023 and ends by 21st January 2023
- Prelims and Finals will be conducted between 12.15 P.M and 3.15 P.M from 23rd January 2023 for all events
- Western Dance and Folk Dance Finalists will be performing on the day of Culturals 2023
- For group events, only one registration is required for a team (2nd and 3rd years)
- Necessary materials and instruments have to be brought by the participants for all the events
- Decision of the Judge is final for all the events
- Participation in all events is restricted only for Sathyabama students

 No act shall contain any offensive, obscene, disrespectful actions or gestures. The act will be immediately stopped and the entry of the participant / group will be immediately disqualified, if any instructions are not followed.

SOLO EVENTS - RULES

Classical Song / Western Vocal (Solo)

- 1. Time allotted for each participant performance is 3 minutes.
- 2. The participants will be judged based on the song selection, voice quality, clarity, rhythm and their appeal to the audience.
- 3. The participants should bring their own musical instruments, if required during the performance.
- 4. The participants can bring karaoke in a pen drive and should submit in the venue allotted at least half an hour prior to the start of the event.

T Shirt Painting

- 1. The theme should be strictly adhered. Theme: Sathyabama Campus
- 2. Plain T Shirt, Paint, paint brushes and all other necessary stationery are to be brought by the participant
- 3. Time duration is one hour

Portrait Drawing

- 1. The name of a personality will be given on the spot
- 2. All necessary stationary items are to be brought by the participant
- 3. Time duration is one hour

Free Style Dance

- 1. Time allotted for each participant's performance is 90 seconds.
- 2. The participants will be judged based on the steps, grace, expression, costume, song selection and their appeal to the audience.
- 3. All kinds of dances are permitted (Folk, Western, Classical)
- **4.** Participants should bring the audio track in mp3 format and submit in the venue allotted at least half an hour prior to the start of the event.

Mono Acting

- 1. Participants will be given 5 minutes to prepare.
- 2. Each participant will be given 2 minutes to perform their act.
- 3. Theme will be given on the spot.
- 4. Obscenity and offensive gestures are strictly not allowed.
- 5. Decision of the judge will be final and binding

Photography

- 1. Take a photograph in the theme "COLOURS"
- 2. Name, Register Number and the contact number of the student should be written at the back of the photograph and should be submitted at Viscom Department, on or before 29th January,2023

V.J Hunt

- 1. Participants will be judged on the basis of their performances in three rounds.
- 2. Topics will be given on the spot.
- 3. Performance of the participants will be analyzed based on their fluency, spontaneity, presentation, sense of humor, communication skills and interaction with the audience.

Mug Painting

- 1. Participants should bring the mug, paint and other necessary materials
- 2. The painting shall be completed strictly within 15 minutes
- 3. No obscene / objectionable / controversial pictures or statements are allowed and leads to disqualification

GROUP EVENTS

Western Dance / Folk Dance

- 1. Each team will have a time slot of 3 to 4 minutes, which includes time for stage setup.
- 2. The minimum number of participants is 10, maximum 14
- 3. Vulgarity of any form leads to immediate disqualification
- 4. Team leader should give the team details to Ms. Daphine Desona, Asst. Prof/CSE Dept. after completing Google form registration
- 5. Participants should bring the audio track in mp3 format and submit in the venue allotted at least half an hour prior to the prelims.

Group Singing

- 1. Time allotted for each performance is 3 minutes
- 2. Minimum number of participants is 04 and maximum is 06
- 3. The participants will be judged based on the song selection, synchronization, harmony, voice quality, clarity, rhythm and their appeal to the audience.
- 4. Participants should bring their own properties, if required during the performance.
- 5. Participants can bring karaoke in a pen drive and should submit in the venue allotted at least half an hour prior to the start of the event.

Rangoli

- 1. A minimum of 3 and a maximum of 4 participants shall form a team.
- 2. Theme will be given on the spot
- 3. Duration is one hour
 - All the necessary materials need to be brought by the participants

Ethnic Walk – Fashion Show

- 1. Each team will have a time slot of 5 minutes, which includes time for stage setup.
- 2. The minimum number of participants is 10
- 3. Only decent traditional costumes are allowed.
- 4. Vulgarity of any form leads to immediate disqualification.
- 5. Team leader should give the team details to Ms. Daphine Desona, Asst. Prof/CSE Dept. after completing Google form registration
- 6. The participants should bring the audio track in mp3 format and submit in the venue allotted at least half an hour prior to the prelims.
- 7. Team will be judged based on creativity, attitude, formation, attire and style of presentation

Street Play

- 1. Each team can have 4-8 members
- 2. Theme: SMART PHONE A SMART SOCIAL EVIL
- 3. Time limit is 10 minutes for each team.
- 4. Teams will be judged based on script presentation, expressions, creative component and narration

Short Film- OPEN GENRE

- 1. Submitted entries must be original, created, and/or taken by the contestant.
- 2. It must not contain any materials owned or controlled by a third party for which you have not obtained a license, and must not infringe the copyright, trademark, moral rights, rights of Privacy/publicity, or intellectual property rights of any person or entity.
- 3. Entrants will retain all ownership rights to the film submitted. Post submission the entrants are deemed as given permission to the university to publish their work in social media platforms.
- 4. The film can be a fiction or animation. The original film may be produced on HD format and, it is advisable to submit the film in MP4 or .mov format.
- 5. Total running time must be 10 minutes in length including front and back credits.
- 6. The short film can be in regional language with respect to the location of the host University i.e., Tamil or in English
- 7. Censor Certification is not mandatory for the film screening
- 8. Film once selected and submitted for final screening will not be allowed to be withdrawn under any circumstance, and no changes will be entertained after submission.
- 9. Film should be submitted on or before 29th January, 2023
- 10. Juries decision is final and binding in all matters
